CAMP PROGRAMME AND SPORT INFORMATION:



AMERICAN FOOTBALL/RUGBY

OVERVIEW

This is a world-first for Africa, with top talent scouts and former NFL players coming to South Africa to assess local and international athletes as well as examine the individual to see if they have the necessary skills to make it big in one of the world's most lucrative sporting codes.

Based on the NFL combine concept; this sporting code is strictly based on 'no-contact'. Coaches and Scouts will instruct athletes to demonstrate a specific drill, thereafter, they will examine their capabilities.

All that is required is pure talent.

WWS deems this event to be advantageous to all rugby players between the ages of 15-21 years (who will be allowed to attend the camp), for it will kick open many doors and provide several opportunities, such as:

1. High school, Junior colleges, NAIA (National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics) Universities, and NCAA (National Collegiate Athletic Association) Universities.
2. Scouting camps and trials in Europe.
3. Training camps through the High School and University system in USA.

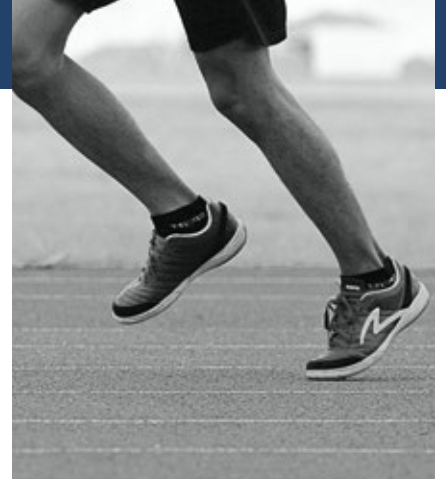
Our scouting network is topped off by the fact that World Wide Scholarships is the only certified scouting and recruiting service on the African continent by the NCAA.

SKILLS TESTING

Rugby players will be put through a vigorous testing regime based on the position they play in rugby which would translate to American football.

ALL PLAYERS WILL BE PUT THROUGH GENERAL NFL TESTING.

1. 40 yard dash
2. 3 cone drill
3. Standing long jump
4. Vertical jump
5. Bench press / Push ups test
6. 5 /10 /5 shuttle / Pro shuttle



FURTHER TESTING EXPLANATION:

- All players will be put through general NFL Testing. 6. 5-10-5 (Pro shuttle) Technique.
- Backline players in Rugby will go through defensive back, running back, and wide receiver testing, which are positions in American Football which are like the backline position in Rugby.
- Forwards and scrum players will go through line backer, defensive end, or offensive lineman testing, which are positions in American Football which are like the forward and scrum position in Rugby.
- Talented kickers will go through punting and goal kicking tests, using the American Football equipment and balls.

OVERVIEW

Our aim is to “change the game” by allowing not only basketball players but also Netball players and individuals who meet the athletic requirements necessary to play the sport. In Africa we have the most athletically talented individuals and often this talent goes unnoticed due to lack of resources and opportunity. This year, we will be creating videography and profiling for each athlete to ensure that they are able to be easily aligned with any scouting network necessary to take them to the next level. This is open to girls and boys aged 15-21 years old.

SKILLS TESTING

Dribbling abilities, shooting abilities, pick and roll/pop, footwork, playmaking abilities, post moves, court awareness and the ability to be coached/mental toughness.

BASKETBALL SPORTS SCIENCE TESTING

There will be 8 testing stations allocated on each court which will have Sport Student Scientists testing the athletes. The overall testing time frame will last (+/-9min) but athletes will move in a clockwise rotation every 1 min to the next station.

75 Sports Science students overall (Working at the stations).

THE 8 STATIONS ARE:

1. 1st Station – Basic Profile details (Name, Surname and etc.)
2. 2nd Station – Anthropometry Test (Height, Size, Length and etc.)
3. 3rd Station – Shooting Technique (Shooting percentage, form, movement and etc.)
4. 4th Station – Vertical Jumps (Jumps, landing and etc.)
5. 5th Station – Agility
6. 6th Station – Ball Skills (Ball Co-ordination, Dribbling and etc.)
7. 7th Station – Speed (Half court and full court)
8. 8th Station – Muscle strength (Burpees)

OVERVIEW

To whom it may concern,

Camp Discovery would like to confirm the following procedures that have been implemented regarding Covid-19:

Camp Discovery has been in lockdown since the first announcement of Level 5 regulations by the President of South Africa. Our staff have been isolated on our premises and have, under exceptional circumstances, not been allowed to leave the premises since the announcement.

Any and all staff re-entering the premises are placed under quarantine, with antibody testing performed on arrival and monitoring done every day, including temperature control and symptom evaluation, until it is determined that they are fit to exit the quarantine and rejoin the team.


We further place on record that Camp Discovery has not had any Covid-19 incidents and that we will continue to strictly adhere to the rules and regulations imposed by the South African Government.

All service providers entering the premises are sanitized on arrival, temperature taken and they are obliged to wear masks for the entire duration that they are on the premises.

With respect to clients arriving on site, our rules state that no client will be allowed onto the premises with any Covid-19 symptoms and that temperature control and symptom evaluation will be monitored daily, during their stay. Should we determine that any of the attendees displays any of the defined symptoms of Covid-19, they will be asked to leave the premises.

Food safety is also of vital importance and therefore our staff have been professionally coached on adhering strictly to the rules and regulations when preparing and serving food. Bidfood, the food delivery service provider, has undertaken to comply and adhere to the rules and regulations.

- **How many players will you scout? There is no limit to the number of players being scouted.**

All participants will receive a scouting profile. There are numerous opportunities for talented individuals. What is important is to prove your talent.

- **Am I guaranteed to get to get a scholarship?**

No, it is subject to your talent

- **Are scholarships only available to USA and Europe?**

WWS has a worldwide network of opportunities so it is not limited to USA and Europe only. It also includes local universities and other placements.

- **What happens after you have been scouted?**

We present you to the appropriate partners. There will be individuals and teams that will be selected to go on an international tour that will be paid for by selected players. In every sport there will be a golden ticket and they will be paid for (top soccer player, top football player, top boy and girl basketball player).

- **Do the options include sports only or academics as well?**

It is only for sports, but academics will contribute a lot if you are not selected solely for sports. All applicants older than 15 years should include their academic transcripts. We must keep in mind eligibility which has to do with grades since our core is linking people with universities and professional clubs.
